
How do I find a course?

You can search for a course in the 'Find a training course' quick search on the [home page](#):

- 1 Type any keywords that you know about the course or occupation
- 2 Select the drop-down filters if you want to limit the search to a course type and/or industry
- 3 Select the 'Find my course' button



- 4 The results that match your criteria will be displayed, with the closest matches listed at the top.

How do I refine my course search?

You can refine the course search after using the quick search on the [home page](#) or by:

- ❷ Refine your search by course type, qualification and/or funding details
- ❸ Select the 'Apply filter' button
- ❹ The results that match your criteria will be displayed, with the closest matches listed at the top

Fee-free training for Year 12 graduates

Overview
 Year 12 graduates will be able to access fee-free training in high priority areas from January 2014.
 To be eligible for fee-free training, Year 12 graduates need to commence training in a high priority qualification with a pre-approved training provider within the calendar year following the completion of Year 12.
 The Fee-free training will apply to [high priority qualifications](#) available under the Queensland Government's [Certificate 3 Guarantee](#) program or [User Choice](#) program, which funds workplace-based apprenticeship and traineeship training.

Participant eligibility
 To be eligible to access fee-free training, you must:

- have completed Year 12 in Queensland and hold a Senior Statement issued by the Queensland Studies Authority
- enrol and start training with an approved training provider by the end of the calendar year following the completion of Year 12
- be a Queensland resident.

Considering your training choice
 Year 12 fee-free training is available through two Queensland Government skills and training investment programs - the Certificate 3 Guarantee and User Choice.
 It is important to carefully consider your training options before committing to a training course as this may exhaust your entitlement to further Queensland Government subsidised training.

Accessing fee-free training for Year 12 graduates

Step 1 - Select a qualification
 Think about the career or area of study you are interested in and then review the [high priority list](#) to find a matching qualification.
 If your preferred qualification is an apprenticeship or traineeship and you want to find out more about what is involved, including the opportunities and benefits they can provide, visit the [Apprenticeships Info website](#).

Step 2 - Choose a training provider
 If you wish to complete a high priority vocational education and training course available through the Certificate 3 Guarantee program, contact an approved training provider directly to enrol. Visit the [list of qualifications and training providers](#)* for further details.

Installs, maintains and repairs electrical wiring and electronic components in motor vehicles. Registration or licensing may be required.

Skills
 Most occupations in this unit group have a level of skill commensurate with the qualifications and experience outlined below. AQF Certificate III including at least two years of on-the-job training, or AQF Certificate IV (ANZSCO Skill Level 3)

Tasks

- using test equipment to locate electrical and electronic malfunctions
- dismantling and removing electrical and electronic assemblies and components
- installing electrical equipment and electronic components in motor vehicles
- connecting power-operated vehicle equipment and accessories to power supply
- adjusting engine control systems and timing
- testing and replacing defective alternators, generators, voltage regulators and starter motors
- repairing and replacing faulty ignition and electrical wiring
- replacing defective parts such as fuses, lamps and switches
